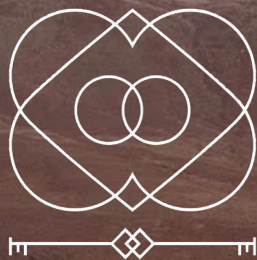

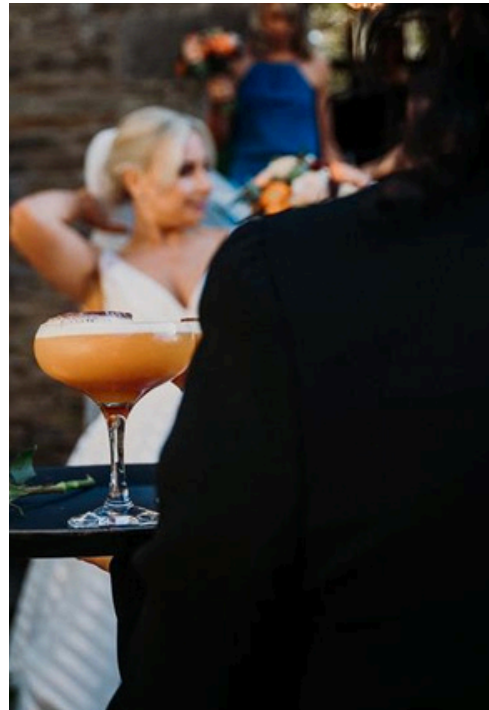

ACCOMMODATION

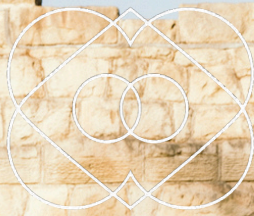

Together, they offer ample space for family and friends to stay and celebrate under one roof. With separate wings and cosy corners throughout the estate, there’s room for everyone to relax, while the layout allows both wedding parties to get ready on-site in comfort and privacy before coming together for the ceremony. Any non-resident guests will be taken back to Hayfield village by Upper House minibuses before 12:30am. Rest assured that they have a great choice of accommodation if they wish to stay locally. There is a local campsite which has pods open all year round, B&Bs, several pubs, and a variety of holiday cottages and Airbnb’s.
